

Guide to scoring points on different activities

Outcome No 1 – Maximum points 20

Participation at meetings or academic activities

Designated activities

- College Lecture, YPF, Guest Lectures, Specialty days, AAS, Regional/outstation meetings
 - Participants – 3 points per hour, 2 points per ½ hour
 - Resource persons – 5 points per hour, 3 points per ½ hour

Non designated activities

- Local meetings, case conferences, journal clubs, non routine teaching
 - Participants – 2 points per hour, 1 points per ½ hour
 - Resource persons – 4 points per hour, 2 points per ½ hour

Evidence of participation should be annexed

- Certificate of participation, receipt of registration or attendance should be verifiable (attendance register)

Outcome No 2 – Maximum points 20

Participation at skills training workshops/any other skills related activity

e.g. CPR, IT

- Participants – 3 points per hour, 2 points per ½ hour
- Resource persons – 5 points per hour, 3 points per ½ hour

Outcome No 3 – Maximum points 10

Organizing or participating in a voluntary health service to the community

e.g. health camps

- 2 points per item

Outcome No 4 – Maximum points 20

Research and publications

- Recognized journal (Index medicus listed) – 10 points per article
- Local journal/book/contributing to scientific documents – 5 points per item
- Contribution to non professional publication or a lecture to such group – 3 points per item

Evidence of publication/ letter of invitation to be attached

Outcome No 5 – Maximum points 30

Self learning activities

Points granted per item of activity

- E.g. web based/ postal updates/ newsletters etc – 2 points
- Reading on a topic or article and writing a summary of what you learn – 2 points
- Reflective learning – 2 points per entry
 - E.g. experience or something you have done with reference to your own mistakes or drawbacks and how you would improve them – a critical analysis
- Audit – 5 points
- Any other item accepted by CCP – 2 points

N.B.

- Credit points will be calculated based on a Portfolio maintained by the doctors
- 50 credit points for 12 calendar months will be needed for revalidation
 - For Specialists 50% of the points /year (i.e. 30 credit points) should be scored from specialty related activities. These activities should be ratified by the respective specialist body)
